Program practice will be 10-15 minutes of your child's school day, each day. If you do not want your child to participate, your child's teacher will arrange for other activities during that time. Betsie Valley has been very blessed by the generosity of others and outside organizations. We would love to help our students give back, too. One way our students can help others is by donating gently used or outgrown coats, snow pants, or boots to the box in the lobby. These will be donated to the Copemish Clothing Closet.

Another way that our students can help others in need is to hold a Penny Door War. Each classroom will decorate their classroom door. The classroom that collects the most pennies (pennies count for positive points, silver coins and dollars count as negative points) will be the winning class. The winning class will receive a reward. All money collected will be used to purchase toys for the Benzie County Toys for Tots program. Last year our students raised over \$700 in just 2 weeks. That donation was generously matched by The Corner Toy Store in Frankfort for a total of \$1400 in toys. The Corner Toy Store has offered to match what we raise again this year. Let's see if we can break last year's record!

Next, I would like to thank everyone who placed an order with Mountain Colors for our art fundraiser. We raised \$145.00 to spend on art materials between the two schools.

Here is a brief overview of the skills we have been working on in each grade.

Kindergarten - Line, shapes and rainbow colors

1st Grade - Primary colors, Henri Matisse and Piet Mondrian

2nd Grade - Secondary colors, horizon line, foreground, middleground, and background

3rd Grade - Warm and cool colors, horizon line, foreground, middleground, and background

4th Grade - Complementary colors, positive and negative space, contour lines

5th Grade - Monochromatic colors, positive and negative space, contour lines

The children's artwork from the past quarter is hanging up in the hallways at school if you would like to see it on display. It looks absolutely wonderful.
