Dear Parents and Students,

As the new principal at Lake Ann Elementary I want to welcome you to the 2017-2018 school year. I am excited to be part of such a wonderful school family. We have a very caring and capable staff, supportive families as well as community members and especially great kids. We know that you play an important role in your child’s education. We ask that you guide and support your child’s learning by ensuring that they **attend school daily** and **arrive on time**, ready for the day’s learning experience.

Breakfast:

All students may eat breakfast at school, FREE of charge! This is an effort to have all of our students nourished and ready to learn. Breakfast begins at 8:40am. Students arriving after 9:00am will receive a breakfast bag.

Dismissal:

Lake Ann Elementary staff kindly requests that end of the day dismissal changes be telephoned into us by **3:00pm**. Our end of the day is very hectic and we want to make sure your child is headed to the correct home, day care, or pick up.

We ask that you wait until 3:50pm to arrive for pickup so you can enter the lobby for dismissal without ringing the bell. Please remain in the lobby and your child will come to meet you. If you wish to speak with a teacher, the office can assist you with this. Teachers have a responsibility to get students on buses and to pick up before they are available to parents. Buses are not released until all students are accounted for.

Parking:

Visitors must use the west lot. Staff parking and our bus loading zone occurs in front of the building. The curbside in the visitor lot is also a loading zone. You must remain IN your vehicle. If you wish to come in, please park in a space.

Lunch Application & Prices

Your child will be bringing home a Free and Reduced Lunch Application Form. The information on the forms is held in the strictest confidence. Please fill out the form and return it to the school even if you don't think you qualify. Thanks for your assistance.

Prices: Full Pay Lunch - \$2.65
Reduced Pay Lunch - \$.40
Free Breakfast for all students
Milk - \$.40

If you wish to have lunch with your child please check in at the office and receive a visitors' badge.

Benzie Central students who are not on free and reduced lunch status are expected to maintain a limited balance with the district for breakfast and/or lunch obligations. Student accounts will be reviewed on a bi-weekly basis. Notification will be sent to families when student debt reaches \$5. A letter will be sent to the family requesting immediate payment on the account. Students with a debt of \$5 or more will be offered a lunch (peanut butter sandwich, apple, and milk) until the debt is resolved.

Parent / Visitor Parking

Please remember that during bus drop off (8:30 – 9:15) and pickup (3:30 – 4:15), parents and other visitors are asked to park in the west parking lot only. The front drive and parking area is off limits during this time.

For the safety of our students and staff, please sign in and out at the office and receive a visitors' pass. We appreciate your service and cooperation.

Checking Students In & Out From School

If your son/daughter needs to leave school early (prior to 4:00), please come into the office to check him/her out of school. If they are returning please remember to check them back in at the office where your child will receive a green slip allowing them back into the classroom. We realize there are occasions when you will need to pick up your child before regular dismissal time (4:00). **For the safety of all students we ask parents to wait in the office where your child will be brought to you.**

MEDICATIONS

Medications may be given if the school office has a medication form filled out by the parent. These forms are available in the office. Medication needs to be in the original packaging, such as prescription bottles, Tylenol bottles etc. A student must not carry medicine of any kind on the bus. The exception to this would be that students who need inhalers for an asthmatic condition.

VOLUNTEERS

We love to have volunteers help out in all ways; classroom, library, field trips, PTA sponsored activities, etc. In order to volunteer for a field trip off of school property it is necessary to fill out a Volunteer Release Form every year. This form will be coming home with all the new school paperwork, please fill this out and send back.
