DISTRICT DESCRIPTION: Benzie Central Schools serves over 1,400 students K-12 and encompasses over 350 square miles in the beautiful terrain of Northwest Michigan. There are six villages in the district which is also convenient to the cities of Traverse City, Manistee, and Frankfort. The early childhood program operated by the district is housed at Lake Ann Elementary and services students ages 3-5 through Headstart, Great Start Readiness, and tuition based programming. Benzie Central has 3 elementary schools serving grades K-5 and a middle / high school serving grades 6-12. There is also an alternative / virtual high school situated near the high school campus and a former elementary school currently housing a pre-school program hosted by a regional community agency.
