If you wish to speak with a teacher, the office can assist you with this. Teachers have a responsibility to get students on buses and to pick up before they are available to parents. Buses are not released until all students are accounted for.

#### POSITIVE BEHAVIOR TICKETS

## Parent / Visitor Parking
