However, once the students are released the entire process only takes between 7-13 minutes. What can parents do to make their experience better?

- Front vehicle pull all the way to the front of loading area.
- Arrange vehicle so that their children enter vehicle on the passenger side.
- Teach children to buckle themselves as much as possible.
- Please be patient if arriving early (most of the wait time is prior to students being dismissed)
