FUN HALF DAYS



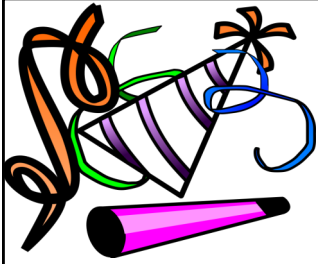
- We will be hosting "Fun Half Days" on one half day of school each month. For \$1, your child can participate in that month's theme. Look for a note home each month informing you about the theme.
