

### Betsie Valley Communicator January 2019

Dear Families,

What an amazing December! Students were able to shop for family members at the Christmas Bazaar (with much thanks to Mrs. Conrad, Mrs. Mosher and Mrs. Campana, and so many other volunteers), share our singing talents at our Christmas Program (with much thanks to Ms. Corey for all of her work), and generously support our neighbors (with much thanks to all of you!). Our school community was able to come together to help a worthy cause, providing toys for families in need, by having a penny war. In just 2 weeks, our school was able to raise \$859.98! The Corner Toy Store of Frankfort matched the money collected bringing our total donation of almost \$1800 worth of toys for families in our community! I could not be more proud of the students and staff! Thank you all for reinforcing why Betsie Valley is such a great community of people!

School resumes on Wednesday, January 7. Students will participate in a CHAMPS camp refresher, where all students review and practice schoolwide expectations, the first week back. We will focus on responsible, respectful, and safe behavior in all areas of the school and playground.

At Betsie Valley we strongly believe that safety of students is our number one priority. Over the course of this school year a few potential concerns have arisen that could impact the safety of students. One concern is last minute bus changes. These occur when families call after the 2:30 pm cut time or when we have last minute changes to after school activities. Given our commitment to the safety and well-being of all students, we are changing the policy for after school events. We will NO longer be able to accommodate last minute requests to attend after school events. All paperwork and money MUST be submitted no later than 2 days prior to the event. This change reflects the need for staff to have timely notice of bus changes and accurate lists of students staying after school. Additionally, we ask that you please make the office aware of any changes to your child's transportation arrangements BEFORE 2:30pm. The office is a very busy place, especially between 3-4pm. Last minute changes placed after 2:30 pm run the risk of not being implemented correctly. Please reserve changes after 2:30 pm for EMERGENCIES ONLY. Thanks for your help with this!

school because of an illness or any other reason, they will not be allowed to attend after school activities. Please allow your child proper recovery time. Children should be fever free for 24 hours before returning to school. Also, please remember that if a student is removed from class during the regularly scheduled school day and is not able to return to the classroom due to behavioral concerns, the student will NOT be allowed to stay after school for any after school events. Our after school events are often staffed by parent volunteers that have not had proper training on how to work with students in crisis. Allowing students that have struggled to maintain safe, responsible, and respectful behavior during the school day to attend an after school event with untrained volunteers could result in unsafe conditions.
