State Test Scores

Benzie recently became the first school district in the region to take advantage of a state program to make state test scores available online to parents and students. You can access these scores through the same login that you use in PowerSchool to check on grades and attendance. The steps to use this new access are described in the attached document.

The program that makes this possible is called MiLearn. It was developed by the Michigan Department of Education and implemented with the help of the Traverse Bay Area Intermediate School District. MiLearn will be updated with future test scores as they become available.
