B. Platte River Elementary School Incident – Superintendent Olson reported that there was an unfortunate incident at Platte River Elementary involving a water leak. Mr. Olson emphasized that this, while unfortunate, is also to be expected when a building is vacant and small problems may go unnoticed. Since that time, cleanup has been done with help of outside contractors and at district expense. Insurance policies do not cover such damage for unoccupied facilities. Board members inquired as to the extent of the damage. Mr. Olson

explained that the gym floor has buckled and suffered some pretty extensive damage as a result. He further indicated that it would be important for the board to consider this new information as we determine the future of the Platte River building and recommended we revisit the topic in the near future.
