End of Day

Dismissal Information

Dismissal time is at 4:00 on regular school days and 11:50 on half days

Any changes to your childs end of day routine need to be to the office at least **1-Hour** before dismissal. You may notify the office via phone, signed note, or by email to vanpoortflieta@benzieschools.net.

Please Note: We will not except a verbal change from a student. Any changes made after 3pm on regular school days or 10am on half days may not be received!

HEADLICE

When a student is found to be infested with head lice, parents will be notified as soon as possible. The student may stay at school through the remainder of the day but may not ride home on the bus (or the parent may choose to pick up their child for immediate treatment). The student will need to be transported by parent/guardian following treatment and would be readmitted when they are examined by available school personnel and it is confirmed that the child is free of any live lice or viable nits. Parents of students with non-viable nits will be notified. The best way to prevent the spread of lice is for parents to check for lice regularly and treat as needed.
