- 1) Mail your Absentee Ballot
  Application to your local township
  clerk by July 30th. Township hall
  mailing addresses and phone
  numbers are located on the back of
  this sheet
- 2) Absentee Ballots will be mailed to your home; Ballots are first available no later than June 22
- 3) Vote!
- 4) Mail your Ballot back to your local township clerk by August 4th

- Absentee Ballots are first available no later than June 22nd
- Go to your local township hall to hand in your Application; you can immediately fill out your Ballot. Township hall addresses and phone numbers are located on the back of this sheet
- 3) Vote!
- 4) You can vote Absentee up until Aug 4th, 8:00pm
