## 3. Technology

- a. Bret Emerson (CommTech) is on site today (field work for Paging Systems)
  - i. Paging System: going out for bids end of August; Update
  - ii. SCHEDULE mid-August meeting to review Tech Scope at New Elem
  - iii. Tech "TC" DD drawings will be issued with Kingscott drawings
  - iv. "TR" drawings for raceway will be issued for raceway work
  - v. Paging Upgrades: ready to bid; Target award at 10/11 Board mtg
  - vi. Post bids on State of Michigan SIGMA web site (Michelle at District)
  - vii. HS Weight Rm Question: how much video capability needed?
    - 1. Amiee will confirm and get back to Bret
    - 2. Typically use music and a timer (switch equipment stations)
    - 3. Currently no sound system changes planned for main gym
- b. Budget / Scope:
  - i. Bret will do an estimate of the DD technology work give to Wolgast. Get it done over this
  - ii. Paging system is outside of bond scope could use ESSER funds to cover this
- c. Other technology items?
  - i. 1 x 2 speakers? Bret found a direct 1 to 1 replacement in hallways for paging upgrades





#### 4. Communication

- a. 8/9 Board Meeting: give an overall design update
  - i. Remote is fine
  - ii. Overall update on all projects
- b. 9/2 Open houses: display images on 30" x 42" boards
  - Amiee would like one board with all building "designs" plus one board specific to each building showing enlarged design information
  - ii. Send Amiee flat sheets only (she will clip on to foam core boards)
  - iii. Send extra foam core boards (2) per building
- c. 9/13 Board Meeting: present "Options" to the Community for input
  - i. In person
  - ii. 6:00pm meeting with community then 7:00pm mtg with Board
  - iii. Overall update on all projects

## 5. Design Process

- a. New Elementary
  - i. Exterior materials & colors: Review options today
    - Option A: browns/tans with red accent above windows; large scale brick base, standard brick above, siding above windows
    - 2. Option B: gray/tans more muted (same color as HS); large scale brick between windows; siding above pairs of windows; reddish accent above window
    - Option C: dark large scale base; HS brick above; cedar colored beams/columns; cedar colored accent above window; white siding above window. More "Modern" look; closer to HS addition
    - 4. FEEDBACK / DIRECTION
      - a. Like option "C" but feels it might clash with HS.
      - b. Like option "B" but with "Cedar" color wood at entry canopy.
      - c. Don't like the amount of "White" on option "C"
      - d. Maybe introduce RED glazed brick at main entry
      - e. Gym: don't like the white color; worried it will look bad over time; change to RED and add a BLACK band
      - f. Board Meeting on 8/9
        - i. Opt 1 RED and black focus
        - ii. Opt 2 More traditional; close to "B"; Use Benzie RED accents
        - iii. SEND REVISED IMAGES TO AMIEE BY NOON THIS FRIDAY
        - iv. Board will review / approve on 8/9
  - ii. Interior materials & colors: Review options today
    - 1. Opt 1 "Orchard View": two bold colors; warm palette; removed orange from previous option; added black.
    - 2. Opt 2 "Sunny Point": three bolds colors; added rustic LVT's; removed orange; tweaked the green.





- Laura presented 3D sketches showing initial ideas for possible color placement and color patterns on the floor
- 4. FEEDBACK / DIRECTION
  - a. Sunny Point Group does not like to green PLAM on "Sunny Point"
  - b. Present to the Board on 8/9 as options (before it goes to community on 9/13)
- iii. DTE meeting results: options for moving forward
  - 1. Kris Gerke did a quick quantity take-off for the Access Road on the Schools' property: 40,000 SF of road could easily be \$800,000 added cost to the project
  - 2. Status of access road profiles (at gas line crossings) for DTE? Aaron will email profiles and copy Amiee HIGH PRIORITY
  - 3. Amiee says road commission stance is why should they move forward with any access road planning / design if DTE is going to oppose the gas line crossings
  - 4. Current plan requires (4) crossings and (4) sets of gates (to prevent people from turning and driving on the gas main)
  - 5. Aaron presented a "Plan B" for the new access road to be on theschools property; there is room to add this access road without moving the new elementary building from its current proposed location.
  - 6. FEEDBACK / DIRECTION
    - a. Cost of new access road on school property is a big concern for Amiee
    - b. Access road alongside the practice field is a safety concern
    - Aaron says we could eliminate the northernmost gas line crossing; Amiee wants to keep the 2 in the middle (to have separate crossing drives for bus and parents)
    - d. ACTION ITEMS: Aaron revise the concept to eliminate the north crossing; send the proposed paving profiles to DTE today!
- iv. Washer/Dryer from Crystal Elementary: gas or electric?
  - 1. They are ELECTRIC
- v. Single use toilet rooms: Does Mike want a floor drain in each?
  - 1. Mike wants floor drains in each single each toilet room
- vi. Building generator: will be included for emergency lighting and power for phones / internet
- b. Lake Ann Elem
  - i. Kingscott team proceeding with Construction Documents (CD)
  - ii. Wolgast team working on Design Development (DD) cost estimate
- c. HS Addition & Locker Room Remodeling
  - i. Kingscott team proceeding with Design Development
  - ii. Additional work at south parking lot





- District wants to add the new exit drive for the "Parent" loop (near where the building sign is located)
- 2. District is willing to revise interior work scope / finishes to make room for this in the overall budget
- 3. This work would likely be done in conjunction with the New Transportation Building site work
- 4. District would like "Construction" to use the in and out drive by the Auditorium for construction activities so that they can use the in/out further west (allow them to still access the service side of the HS Building)
- iii. Existing Kiln Room: is there an existing grille for the Kiln? Dan will send Mike an Email
- iv. Gym Balcony work scope reminder:
  - 1. Tectum partition wall will stay
  - 2. CMU wall at "Stack" area will be demolished (to make room for batting cage)
  - 3. Owner will relocate existing battling cage to balcony level
- d. Transportation Building
  - i. Kingscott team proceeding with Construction Documents (CD)
  - ii. Wolgast team working on Design Development (DD) cost estimate
  - iii. Hotsy Bus Wash: Chad at Benzie Bus said issue is EGLE requirements for discharge water from the undercarriage wash. Chand has no problem with the Hotsy system / product.
- e. Betsie Valley Remodeling (Phase 2)
  - i. Kingscott team proceeding with Design Development (DD)
  - ii. District would like to improve the front canopy if budget allows; replace front doors; maybe some new landscaping, etc.
- f. HS / MS Remodeling (Phase2)
  - i. Kingscott proceeding with Design Development (DD)
  - ii. Servery Expansion: Amiee question about State BCC review
    - 1. New serving line equipment is ordered and arriving end of September 2021
    - 2. Associated remodeling work (new alum storefront, sliding doors, electrical power, etc.) is planned to bid out in January 2022
    - 3. Dan and Kris will discuss Servery Expansion Timing to see if timeframe can be moved earlier (Xmas Break or Spring Break)
    - 4. HS MS Cafeteria Remodel: District would like Cafeteria to be remodeled during Summer 2022 (NOT summer 2023)
  - iii. Air Conditioning: do you want A/C in the Central Office?
    - 1. Yes if we afford to do it
    - 2. Kingscott: include A/C as an ADD ALTERNATE in the bid documents
  - iv. Existing ductwork: TAB work status Dan will send Mike an Email
  - v. Cast iron sanitary lines: Roto Rooter scope / camera status Dan will send Mike an Email
