

Bid Advertisement for Snow Removal Services

Benzie Central Schools is seeking bids for snow removal services at the following locations:

Contract Details:

- **Duration:** Three years
- **Snow Removal Requirement:** The contractor must have the ability to clear and/or remove a normal heavy snowfall before 6 AM.

Submission Guidelines:

Bids must be submitted to the Director of Operations, Mike Zielinski, at the following address by **Thursday, November 7, 2024 at noon**:

Bids should be sealed and clearly marked "Snow Bid." **Bids will be opened at 12:02 pm on November 7th**, and a recommendation for contract award will be made at the Board of Education meeting on **November 11, 2024**.

Important Notes:

The Board of Education reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to accept the bids that are in its best interest.

Snow Removal Specifications:

- 1. Maintain driveways, parking lots, service areas, and bus drop-off loops, ensuring all drives in front of the school are plowed away from the building.
- 2. The contractor is responsible for all snow removal areas mentioned and additional charges for unforeseen circumstances may be allowed only after discussion with and agreement of the Director of Operations.
- 3. Snow removal will commence for any accumulation of 2 inches or more.
- 4. All areas must be cleared by 6:00 AM, Monday through Saturday. Additional daytime clearing is expected when snowfalls accumulate and may be required for evening activities, ensuring no damage or obstruction to vehicles.
- 5. The contractor must have equipment capable of applying "down pressure" on the blade and managing snow to keep lots usable.
- 6. Liability insurance of \$100,000 per occurrence is required, with proof provided to the Board of Education.
- 7. Contract duration: November 11, 2024, through June 30, 2027.
- 8. Payment will be made in five equal installments, starting in December 2024.
- 9. A monthly log of dates, times, and duration of operations must be submitted to the Director of Operations.
- 10. The contractor is responsible for protecting shrubs, bushes, and trees from damage during snow removal and for repairing any damages outside of standard services.
- 11. The Board of Education reserves the right to terminate the contract or seek reparations for non-compliance.
